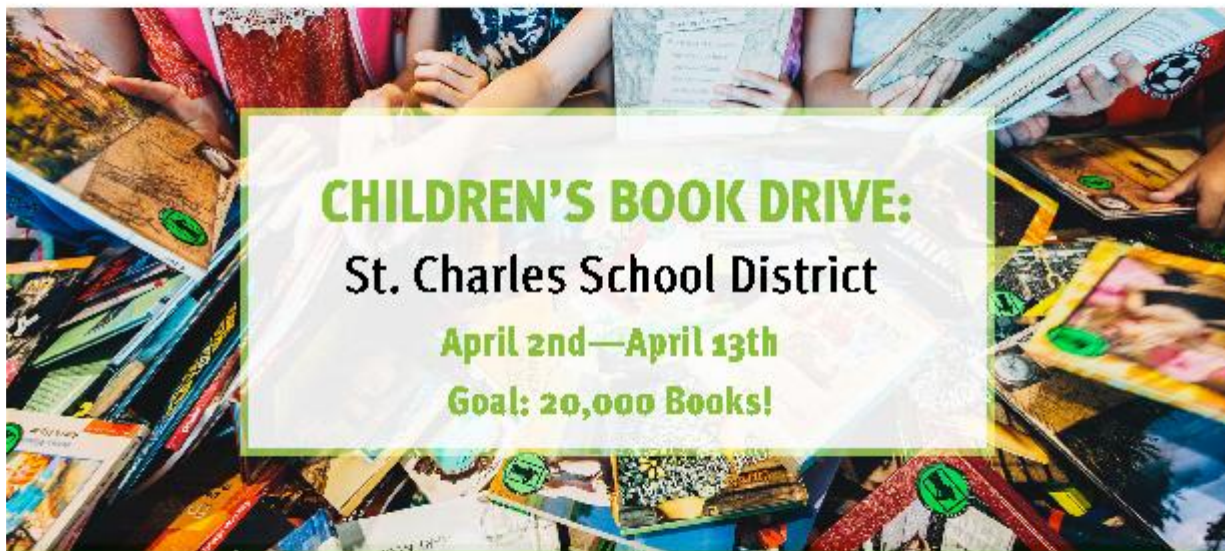
Friday, April 13th at 6:30 PM
