Thank you to all of the parents who were able to attend our Curriculum Nights on Monday and Tuesday. It was wonderful to see so many parents! If you were unable to attend, please feel free to contact your child's classroom teacher or myself if you have any questions.

At our curriculum nights, I shared information about our new math resource. Our district has adopted Eureka Math as our elementary resource. Below is a link that shares information about Eureka. The video is about 7 minutes long and gives some background on the program as well as the shifts in math instruction that have been taking place over the past few years.

Another topic that was shared on Monday and Tuesday was our Champs expectations throughout our building. The Lincoln staff worked together at the start of the year to build common expectations in different areas of the school. We then shared these at an assembly on the second day of school and had classes take a "field trip" through the building to demonstrate expectations in each area. Teachers are also using Champs within their classrooms. Each type of activity has an expectation for Conversation, Help, Activity, Movement, and Participation. Staff has been working with students to encourage and support the implementation of our Champs program over the past week. We are already seeing a positive impact on our learning environment!

The Lincoln School office hours are 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM daily. The office phone number is 331-228-2500. *Messages can be left on voicemail 24 hours a day.* Please report your child's absence before 9:00 AM. The school day begins at 8:40 AM and ends at 3:00 PM for grades 1-5 Lincoln students. For AM Kindergarten the school day begins at 8:40 AM and ends at 11:15 AM. For PM Kindergarten the school day begins at 12:25 PM for and ends at 3:00 PM.

Pre-Arranged Absence Forms

Absences (other than sick days or doctor appointments) during the school year are considered UNEXCUSED unless a pre-arranged absence form is completed. This form allows students to make-up homework missed during the absence. Forms must be received at least two school days prior to the absence. Prearranged (Excused) absences shall be limited to five per year.
