Parent Teacher Conferences for Lincoln School

CUSD 303 has chosen an online system for parents to sign up for Parent Teacher Conferences. It is called *Pick-A-Time*. Lincoln parents will sign up for Parent Teacher Conferences through a link in Home Access Center starting on October 23rd. You will have until midnight on November 15th to sign-up.

Parent Teacher Conferences will be held on Monday, November 20th 8:00 am - 8:00 pm, and Tuesday, November 21st 8:00 am - noon. Conferences are scheduled at 20 minute intervals.

Morning Arrival

Please do not send your child to school or drop-off earlier than 8:25 each morning unless they have orchestra rehearsal or have an arranged meeting with a staff member. The school doors are still locked and teachers are preparing for their day and are unable to supervise your child before that time.

It is also important to *arrive prior* to the late bell at 8:40. That time is technically the start of the school day and instruction is often delayed or interrupted when children are still arriving at that time or later.

Halloween Parade and Party Information

On Tuesday, October 31st, Lincoln will once again host the annual Halloween Costume Parade at 1:30 PM for grades 1-5 (the AM Kindergarten class will parade through school during the morning). Only Kindergarten students will arrive to school in their costumes. All other students will bring their costumes to school and change into them before the parade. In the event of rain, the parade will be held indoors.

For those parents who wish to have their children participate in the parade, please follow the guidelines below:



- Students must be able to put their own costume/make-up on without assistance.
- No masks may be worn by students.
- No costumes and/or make-up may be worn that depicts blood and violence.
- Students are not to bring anything that resembles a weapon of any fashion, even if it part of a costume.
- No bare midriffs or scant clothing.
- Costumes must be appropriate for school and not distract students from the learning environment.
- Students will be asked to remove any parts of the costume that are not within the guidelines.

If you do not wish for your child to participate in the costume parade, please contact your child's teacher or the main office. Lincoln will offer an alternative activity for those students which may include watching a movie or playing games.

Classroom parties will begin following the costume parade for grades 1-5. The AM Kindergarten party will start at 10:15 AM. For parents dressing in a costume, please make sure that you also follow the above guidelines. As always, we appreciate your continued support.
